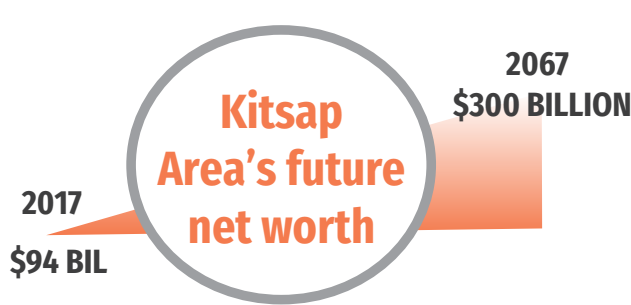
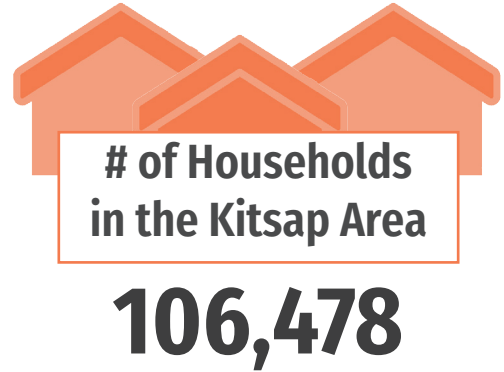

THE 2017 KITSAP AREA TRANSFER OF WEALTH IS A STUDY COMMISSIONED BY LEAVE 10 KITSAP, A COLLABORATION OF LOCAL NONPROFITS, TO DETERMINE WHAT ASSETS ARE AVAILABLE IN THE KITSAP AREA AND TO ENCOURAGE AND INCREASE CHARITABLE GIVING.



THE TOW MODEL PRODUCES SCENARIOS BASED ON PROJECTIONS OF LIKELY FUTURES, NOT PREDICTIONS OR FORECASTS OF ACTUAL FUTURE OUTCOMES. SCENARIOS ARE DRIVEN BY KEY ASSUMPTIONS ABOUT THE FUTURE, BASED ON HISTORICAL TRENDS. IN ALL CASES, WE WORK TO CREATE CONSERVATIVE SCENARIOS THAT REPRESENT REALISTIC ESTIMATES OF TOW OPPORTUNITIES. THE SCENARIO NUMBERS GENERATED ARE NOT PREDICTIVE BUT RATHER DEMONSTRATE POTENTIAL OR A "LIKELY FUTURE" GIVEN PAST AND CURRENT TRENDS.
